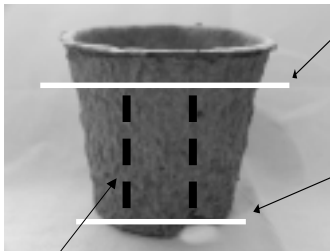

## **Biodegradable Pots**

### **Planting Perennials**



1. Cut off the collar of the pot down to the soil level.

2. Cut off the bottom of the pot to allow roots through faster.

3. Cut slits vertically down the sides of pot.

4. Plant as usual and put removed pieces into the soil or compost bag.

### **Planting Annuals**



1. Remove annual from pot by cutting down or ripping the sides.

2. Plant annual without the pot.

3. Pot should be ripped up and buried into the dirt or disposed of in a compost container.

**Our biodegradable pots only take 6 months to decompose once they are in the ground. Rice pots take three years to decompose and plastic takes about 450 years!**
