🔆 SUNLIGHT TIPS

- Bright, indirect sunlight or fluorescent lighting is ideal.
- Too much sun can dry out your air plants.
- Rolled or wrinkled leaves are signs that they're dry and need to be watered.

NATERING TIPS

- Soaking: 20-30 min, 1-2 times a week
 - ++ Shorter soaks for small air plants and longer for bigger or multiple plants.
 - Misting (best in winter months): Use a fine spray mister, moisten the entire plant, shake off excess if needed

++ 1-2 times between soaks

 Best to use rain or pond water. If using tap water; let water sit for 24 hours.

**Chlorine is not safe for air plants

AIR DRYING

- After watering, shake off all excess from leaves to prevent rotting.
- Place plant upside down on a towel.
- Let sit out for 1-2 hours before returning them to their terrariums or shelf.
